NC will add the paragraph to the application form on the back of the handout. It was agreed to change the handout to A4, and IM and NC will arrange to get some printed. Club Standards AC has discussed this with Gareth. The idea is to motivate and reward runners with an award related to achieving an age adjusted time for each race distance. This could be onerous to administer so the onus should be placed on the runner to produce the required evidence of achievement. 	Membership Fees 2018/19

7.	The costs of organsing CR are covered by the kind sponsorship from Faccenda, meaning that entry fees are currently profit. Consequently, the Club has healthy reserves. It was agreed to cover the whole of each Club runner's entry to the MK Festival of Running, fund the cross-country entries, fund the Hilly 100 teams, offer more training, and pay for a social event to celebrate the Club's 10 th anniversary in 2018. 	Club Gifts	
9.	The committee discussed how the Club should reward members who make additional contributions to the running of the Club over and above the norm, and also to outgoing committee members, where appropriate. All of these are at the discretion of the Committee. It was agreed that a cap of £25 should be made on all gifts acknowledging members, and that a token trophy may be presented to committee members, if appropriate, on presentation night.

	Session Leaders

	Any Other Business	
	RM proposed that the Club explore seeking Sports England's Clubmark. This is a generic accreditation scheme for clubs whose sports' governing body does not run its own scheme. Achieving Clubmark would support the development of the Club, and provide assurance to new and existing members that the Club is well run. It was agreed to look into this further and discuss it at the next meeting. RM will send around web links to the scheme and standards.	RM
